Tom Schultz assumed ownership and control of the company in 2004 and the decision was made to change the name of the company to Disabled Veteran Enterprises, Inc. Tom is a very close family friend and has been an advisor to the company for many years. Tom brings an extensive back ground in operations, procurement, material management, sales and marketing for companies such as Beatrice Foods, Turtle Wax and Amway Corporate Headquarters.
